

How to make the Ron Paul 10'x10' Sign

Supplies:

- 10'x10' tarp
- Black Sharpie Magnum 44 markers
- Red, Black and White spray paint (Good Quality)
- Long thin piece of wood

Steps:

1. Layout on tarp on a flat surface
2. Position the head stencil and tape it to the tarp.
3. Start tracing the head with the Magnum marker, try to use the marker for up to 5 inches from the edge, leaving only the middle for spray paint (where the ear should be)

4. Position the Ron Paul for President text below the head.
5. Cover the "For President" part with scrap cardboard.
6. Paint the "RON PAUL" with Red spray paint. While you are spray painting, be sure to use the thin wood stick to hold down the cardboard as you spray to reduce the under spray.
7. Wait about 10min and cover the "RON PAUL" with scrap cardboard.
8. Paint the "For President" with the black spray paint, using the long thin stick to reduce the under spray.
9. Wait 10 min, then remove all the stencils.
10. Some under spray may have caused the words to become illegible, use two scrap pieces of card board and white spray paint to clean up the letters.



You can also use the stencil to make a 10x20 sign
